Your Rights and Protections Against Surprise Medical Bills

Important Transparency in Coverage Machine-Readable File Information

Transparency in Coverage (TIC) regulations require health insurers and group health plans to create machine-readable files (MRFs) that contain the negotiated rates for in-network providers and allowed amounts derived from historical claims for out-of-network providers and make those files publicly available.

These files follow the CMS defined layout and are in the CMS approved format (JSON) and are not meant for a member-friendly search of rates, benefits, or cost sharing. ***Please refer to the member resources available through [anthem.com](https://www.anthem.com) for this information.*** These files will be published on [anthem.com](https://www.anthem.com) and will be updated on the first day of each month.
